



## CCIW HISTORY AND POLITY COURSE

July 28 – August 1, 2008

Sponsored by the Christian Church in Illinois/Wisconsin

This intensive five-day course is an opportunity clergy, lay people, and students attending non-Disciple seminaries to attend a quality educational event. This course will fulfill CCIW's History and Polity requirements for standing.

Amy Collier Artman is our instructor for the 2008 Disciples History and Polity Class. Amy is in her last year of writing as a PhD candidate in Church History at the University of Chicago. She has taught the three-year history and polity course for students at the Disciples Divinity House at the University of Chicago and will be teaching our course for the Illinois/Wisconsin Region for the third time. Amy served as co-pastor with her husband David while in Chicago, and is currently a full-time student while her husband serves as senior minister at First Christian Church in Harrison, Arkansas.
